New NDB Airway Track Depiction

This past few months, you may have noticed changes to the track depiction of the NDB airways and air routes on the LO charts. These changes have made air navigation more intuitive. In essence the track has not changed. It is still either a magnetic bearing outbound from the NDB based on the true bearing corrected for magnetic variation at the one quarter distance point between Nav aids in Southern Domestic Airspace, or true bearing outbound from the NDB in Northern Domestic Airspace.

Significantly though, you will now find the track information located as near as practicable to the NDB versus its old location near the Airway, Air Route identifier/MEA/Distance block, thus eliminating any confusion as to whether depicted tracks were inbound or outbound.
